PROJECT NAME

Development of a coordinated system of specialist assistance based on Specialist Centers Supporting Inclusive Education

The aim of the project: is to build a coordinated system of specialized support provided by kindergartens, schools, and special institutions for the benefit of mainstream kindergartens and schools in working with groups of children and students with diverse educational and developmental needs. The project addresses actions in the area of inclusive education.

Project assumption: creation of a network of 285 Specialist Centers Supporting Inclusive Education in Poland. The Specialist Center will be established in a special kindergarten, mainstream school, or special institution. Each specialist center will provide support to 5 mainstream schools and kindergartens. Specialist support will be addressed to a total of 1,425 mainstream kindergartens and schools.

Applicants: Entities running kindergartens, schools, and special education institutions

Project value: 221,970,514.46 PLN

Amount of contribution from European Funds: 183,170,068.53 PLN

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
